Invalid entries report per surgeon

DBIR

General

The **invalid entries report per surgeon** shows the errors and warnings per patient within the registration. The biggest difference with the regular **invalid entries report** is that this list also shows the treating surgeon. This list is therefore (mainly) intended for the individual surgeon.

General buttons:



= Back to report overview.



= Switch between 'invalid entries report' and 'invalid entries report per surgeon'



= Sign out from survey.

Registry related buttons:

The content and method of this **invalid entries report per surgeon** is described below.

General:

By clicking on the text under the various buttons, you will be automatically redirected to the relevant patient in Survey. In this way, the changes can be made immediately.

Surgeon:

Within the registry the treating surgeon (per patient) is requested. The name of this surgeon is shown in this column. The invalid entries report per surgeon can be sorted by surgeon using the sort (arrow) keys behind 'surgeon' (see figure 1).

UPN:

Within the registry the UPN (Unique Patient Number) of each patient is requested. The UPN is shown in this column. The invalid entries report per surgeon can be sorted by UPN using the sort (arrow) keys behind 'upn' (see figure 1).

Name:

Within the registry the name of each patient is requested. The names of these patients are shown in this column. The invalid entries report per surgeon can be sorted by name using the sort (arrow) keys behind 'name' (see figure 1).

Date of birth:

Within the registry the date of birth of each patient is requested. The date of birth of these patients are shown in this column. The invalid entries report per surgeon can be sorted by date of birth using the sort (arrow) keys behind 'date of birth' (see figure 1).


Variable:

The "variable" column shows the relevant variables within the registration that were entered incorrectly. If there are multiple incorrect entries per patient, these are displayed below each other. The invalid entries report per surgeon can be sorted by variable using the sort (arrow) keys behind 'variable' (see figure 1).


Warning/Error:

The invalid entries report per surgeon shows two types of error messages: warning and error.

Warning: unlikely value has been entered, such as date of birth in the near future.

A warning is indicated with an orange dot ().

Error: the value in a field is not entered or entered incorrectly (for example with a value that doesn't exist).

An error is indicated with a red dot ()

Issue:

The "issue" column shows the relevant warning / error (as described above) in text. The invalid entries report per surgeon can be sorted by issue using the sort (arrow) keys behind "issue" (see figure 1).

Note

If changes are made to the patient's registration, the invalid entries report per surgeon must be refreshed. To do so reload the browser page by clicking the refresh button or by pressing F5 on the keyboard.

Please note: it can take up to 10 seconds for the changes to take effect. Do not refresh the page too quickly.
